Subj: SMALL CRAFT ENGINEERING AGENT (EA) DESIGNATION

1. Based on proven successful experience, ideal location, focused watercraft mission, technical expertise, full life cycle/full spectrum/ multi-service experience and capability with boats and craft, Marine Corps Systems Command (MARCORSYSCOM) recognizes Naval Surface Warfare Center Carderock Division (NSWCCD) Combatant Craft Department (CCD) as the Engineering Agent (EA) for the Small Unit Riverine Craft (SURC) and Small Unit Riverine Craft – Escort (SURC-E) Variant.
2. CCD will assist the Program Manager (PM) with full life cycle and full spectrum support for the SURC programs. As the EA, NSWCCD CCD is to provide support for the engineering, test and evaluation, life cycle management, maintenance and logistics requirements incident to research and development, acquisition, in-service engineering and operations support for future systems, special technologies or major modification or improvement programs.
3. Additional USMC support requests for craft such as the Riverine Assault Craft (RAC), Light Strike Craft (LSC,), and other programs will be assigned to CCD based on the task scope and complexity. MARCORSYSCOM will provide policy direction and funding at a level commensurate with the specific EA tasking.
